KEY SEASONAL BEERS

Anchor Summer (4.6% abv.)

First brewed in 1984, a crisp, light and refreshing beer - the first American wheat beer in modern times.

Anchor Bock (5.5% abv.)

Released in celebration of the coming of spring, 'bock' is an incredibly old brewing tradition, usually meaning a beer darker and stronger than the brewery's regular brews.

Anchor Humming (4.5% abv.)

Using a rare hop variety (Nelson Sauvin) Anchor create a unique pale ale with character and a wonderful flavour.

Brooklyn Summer Beer (4.5% abv.)

A modern rendition on English 'light dinner ales', Brooklyn Summer is a golden beer with a crisp bitterness and a citrus / floral aroma – a beer with a very sunny disposition!

Brooklyn Pumpkin Ale (5% abv.)

Early American colonists used pumpkins (which were plentiful, flavoursome and nutritious) blended with barley malt in their beers. Post Road has an amber colour, warm pumpkin aroma and a biscuity-malt centre.

Brooklyn Winter Ale (6% abv.)

Rich Scottish malts provide a deep bready flavour and a full copper colour, pulled into balance by brisk hopping – perfect for the long winter.

Goose Island Summertime (4.7% abv.)

The colour of sunshine, with a light fruity aroma and a hint of fruity acidity, Goose Island Summertime is a Kölsch beer brewed in the traditional German fashion.

Goose Island Mild Winter (5.6% abv.)

Toffee brown, medium-bodied, with a creamy head and an aroma of raisins and freshly baked dark bread, with rich caramel malt and spicy rye flavours.

Goose Island Harvest Ale (5.7% abv.)

This copper coloured ESB is made with Cascade hops and the richest Midwestern malts. A fruity American hop aroma and a toasty malt character make Harvest Ale an extra special beer.

Flying Dog Garde Dog (5.5% abv.)

A traditional French Biere de Garde or "beer for keeping", a classic farmhouse ale brewed in March for drinking during the spring and summer months. A lovely toasted aroma and spicy, malty sweetness.

Flying Dog Woody Creek (4.8% abv.)

A traditional Belgian-style Wit Beer, brewed with unique ingredients including orange peel and coriander, resulting in a refreshing and slightly citrus flavour.

Flying Dog K-9 Cruiser Winter Ale (7.4% abv.)

A dark, sweet and malty winter warmer that will captivate any adventurous craft brew drinker. A true Flying Dog original, K-9 Cruiser is the perfect brew to warm you up in those cold winter months.

Erdinger Schneeweiss (5.6% abv.)

First brewed in 1997, this "snow-white" beer is darker and stronger than the than classic Erdinger Weißbier and is a welcome change during the cold winter months! Schneeweiss goes particularly well with hearty food.

Schneider Eisbock (12% abv.)

With powerful aromas and an intense flavour, Eisbock is perfect as a digestive after a good meal.

Schlenkerla Urbock (6.5% abv.)

A smoked bock for the 'strongbeer season' from October through December. Matured for months in ancient rock-cellar underneath Bamberg and tapped freshly from the oakwood cask.

ORDERING INFORMATION

Seasonal beers are a great enhancement to the speciality beer offering of any establishment, delivering the tastes and experiences which compliment the seasons: light and crisp ales for a hot Summer day, the earthy flavours of Autumn, with robust and spicy Winter warmers.

In addition to the key seasonal beers listed overleaf, we are delighted to be able to offer a selection of additional seasonal beers throughout the year. As you would expect with these specialist beers, production is generally significantly less than the brewery's main brands.

With this in mind, we ask our customers to order their stock of seasonal beers further in advance: this can mean an extra month in the case of the likes of Brooklyn Summer Beer or Schneider Eisbock, but can also mean slightly longer periods between order and delivery for other beers.

Orders for our key speciality beers can still be taken after the end of the month indicated, but availability for these will then be strictly on a "first come, first served" basis.
